

Hahnemühle Weekend and Paper Future Lab by Haus des Papiers Finissage

27.09. – 29.09.2024

On all three days of the Hahnemühle Weekend, you will have the opportunity to get to know and enjoy exciting and innovative artistic positions on the topics of sculptural paper art and sustainability in our current exhibition BALANCED for a reduced admission fee of 5 euros throughout the weekend.

It all kicks off on **Friday, 27.09.2024 at 11 a.m.** with a free guided tour by the Paper Future Lab project manager Annika Lorenz. She will guide you through the exhibition with exciting background information on the artists and works, which include works by the current winners of the Paper Art Award, the Paper Future Labs by Haus des Papiers program and the museum's collection.

Afterwards at **3 pm**, the Berlin print experts from the fine art print manufactory d'mage will be available for you. During a live presentation, they will provide an insight into the technology of digital printing: from data preparation, paper selection, analog retouching techniques and little tricks to art handling. Printing will take place on a Canon IPF-6400.

There will also be a free guided tour of the current exhibition by our director Annette Berr on **Saturday, September 28, 2024 at 2 pm**. This will be followed by our surprise event at **3:30 pm**, with more content to follow.

On **Sunday, 29.09.2024 at 11 a.m.** it will be particularly exciting. Here you will get an insight into the Hahnemühle universe with Bettina Scheerbarth from Hahnemühle, who will address the questions in her lecture "Tree-free Paper": How are new fibers discovered for real artist papers? Which fibers have been used for centuries? What advantages do plant fibers have over cellulose from trees? What about the recycling of fibers or paper?

All the senses are addressed: Listen to the lecture, feel and see the paper and fiber samples from Hahnemühle and smell the ingredients for paper production.

This will be followed by a free guided tour of the current exhibition with director Annette Berr at **2 p.m.**

To mark the end of our summer project Paper Future Lab by Haus des Papiers, a slide show summarizing all the exhibition venues will also be shown on the days of the event.
